Eligibility Condition for Admission to B.Ed. Course (Two Years)

Candidates those have qualified in the entrance examination conducted by the affiliating university (Gauhati University) are eligible for admission in the B.Ed. course as per new system introduced by the NCTE.

Working Hours

The working hours of the college are from 10 AM to 3.30 PM, Monday to Saturday.

Admission to B.Ed 2yr course (Semester system)

Admission to the college is made strictly as per Gauhati University Rules & Regulation and in order of merit. Forms can be obtained from the college campus or by downloading from the college website, www.provincecollege.in, on payment of Rs. 500/-.

Academic Calendar

The academic calendar will be as per Gauhati University schedule, which will be communicated as and when the university publishes the same.

Identity Card

After confirmation of admission into the B.Ed. course, an identity card will be issued which is free.

Library

The college has a well-equipped library with a good number of text books, reference books, and general books mostly related to education and methodology subjects. A trainee can borrow one book for a week. The borrower will be responsible for the loss or damage of any book and will have to pay the cost.

Perusal of Notice Board

Trainees should read regularly all the notices displayed on the Notice Board to become fully aware of the required information. The admission fee is required to be deposited at the time of admission, and it is non-refundable.

Attendance and Discipline

1. A trainee must attend 75% of the lectures delivered in each subject to be eligible to appear in the final B.Ed. Examination. Otherwise, they will not be allowed to fill up the form for the Final B.Ed examination.
2. Pleasant and cordial atmosphere should be maintained during college hours. Intoxicants, smoking and spitting in the classrooms as well as college campus are strictly prohibited.
3. During off periods, candidates should read newspapers, journals, etc.

Co-Curricular & Extra-Curricular Activities

Various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities such as games and sports, music, literary and cultural activities like wall magazine & debate, extempore speech, and academic visits (National Science Day, World Environment Day, National Educational Day, etc.) are celebrated throughout the year. Trainees are encouraged to take active part in all types of programs for their success in all activities. The aim of the college is to make teachers professionally competent, socially conscious, and committed towards human resource development as a whole.

Discipline Maintenance

- a) Great emphasis is laid on discipline and character building. Trainees are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline in college.
 - b) All the Trainees must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authority; violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, indiscipline, or adoption of unfair means during examination will make trainees liable for disciplinary action.
 - c) The B.Ed. (2 years) course is a full-time course. So, no trainee can take any other full-time course simultaneously, and necessary action will be taken if such a case is identified. Cell phones are strictly prohibited during all types of instructional programs and must be switched off during class hours.
 - d) All Scholastic and non-scholastic programmes will run strictly as per the academic calendar of the college distributed in the induction meeting.
 - e) All Trainees must be punctual in attending the programmes as per schedule.
 - f) The trainees of the College will maintain discipline and punctuality for functioning of all academic and non-academic programmes of the college.
